# 2023 Water and Wastewater Budget



The Township has an agreement dated back to 1986 with the Town of Smiths Falls for the service/supply of water and sewer for the <u>Atironto</u> area. The Township owns the underground infrastructure and therefore the increase the Town of Smiths Falls passes ultimately only affects the usage rate not the base rate. The base rate is determined on the expenditures the Township incurs to service the area. The Town passed an increase of water rates in the amount of 5.5% on the usage rate and wastewater in the amount of 3.5% on the usage rate. The Township 2023 budget increase includes a 5.5% for water on the base and 1.5% on the usage and 3.5% for wastewater base and a 1.5% on wastewater usage to the residents in the Atironto service area, effective January 1, 2023. This affects approximately 109 residential units.

The Township has an agreement dated back to 1996 with the Town of Smiths Falls for the service/supply of water and sewer for the **Rideau** area. The residents in this service area have rates set directly by the Town, as the agreement states that the users in the Rideau area are charged **1.75 times the users of the Town of Smiths Falls**. The Town owns the underground infrastructure in this area. The Town approved an increase of 5.5% for water base and usage rate and 3.5% for wastewater base and usage rate. Therefore, the 2023 Budget for the Rideau area includes a 5.5% increase for water and a 3.5% increase for wastewater effective January 1, 2023. This affects approximately 31 residential units.

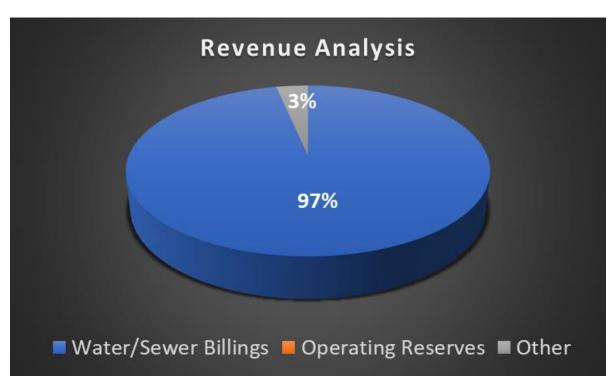

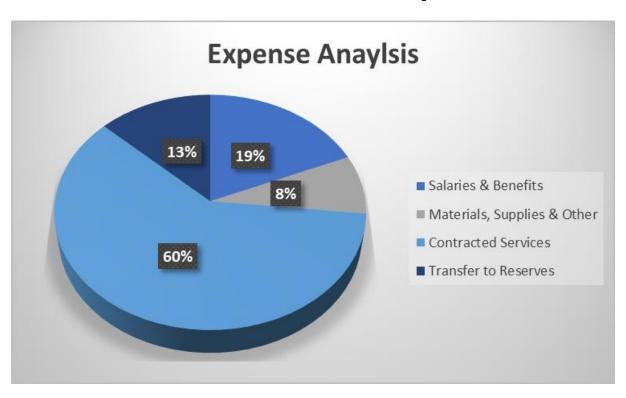

#### Water/Sewer Budget Highlights

A second staff member is continuing to get the hours for Operator certification.

Capital reserves match the longterm financial plan approved by Council for the 2021-2030 years.

The Town of Smiths Falls approved a 5.5% increase in water rates and a 3.5% increase in sewer rates.
